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Terms and Conditions

Stallholders agree to the following:

1. No item may be sold or pre-sold during the event and all activities and information must be supplied to the community FREE of charge (with exception provided for community sellers of Indigenous art or merchandise).
2. No 'fee-paying' services, activity or information is to be promoted. All participating stallholders are to supply their current services FREE of charge to the community (exception provided for community sellers of Indigenous art or merchandise).
3. No individual consultations are to be undertaken, with exception provided to health services if attending to a client's medical needs.
4. No larger marquee spaces will be provided on the day. Should stallholders need a larger marquee space, it is the stallholder's responsibility to request this via this form.
5. All stallholders are to provide a family friendly and culturally appropriate activity on the day. It is encouraged that your activity follows the [2024 NAIDOC theme](#) – "Keep the fire burning! Blak, loud and proud" – encouraging all Australians to come together to celebrate the history and diverse cultures of the country's First Nations people.
6. Stallholders are required to bump in between 8.00am-9.15 am and bump out between 2.30pm-3.30pm. Staff can access Weeip Park/Junction Parade by car using 'Junction Parade' during these times. A site map will be provided 2 weeks before the event.
7. Strictly no cars on the oval at all and all cars must be removed from event location, including Junction Parade, during 9.30am-2.30pm (exception provided for those services who operate from a vehicle. This is for the safety of the general public.
8. All stalls must have a staff member present during the entire event.
9. All stalls must be open 'till 2.00pm even if supplies run out.
10. Stallholders must clean up and dispose of their own rubbish at the end of the event.
11. It is the responsibility of the person signing this form that all staff present at the event are aware of these terms and conditions.
